NOTICE OF WARNING

We have an investigative case report showing that you violated the North Carolina Compulsory Meat Inspection Law and the North Carolina Poultry Products Inspection Law. This reported violation was discussed with you on January 29, 2016. Specifically, our investigation revealed that you had processed, stored, transported, offered for sale and sold Barbecue Chicken, Beef Liver and Hamburger Steak that did not contain State (NCDA) or Federal (USDA) marks of inspection or required labeling, for the sole purpose of resale to the general public. In a signed statement dated January 29, 2016 you stated you processed the misbranded Barbecue Chicken, Beef Livers and Hamburger Steak at your home, transported them to the Curb Market, 208 West Chestnut Street, Goldsboro, North Carolina and in-turn offered for sale and sold the misbranded meat products and poultry products without the benefit of county, state or federal inspection for three (3) years.

Please be advised that the sale of misbranded and/or non-inspected meat products and the sale of misbranded/non-inspected poultry products is a violation of North Carolina General Statute (N.C.G.S.) §106-549.23 and §106-549.56 with civil and/or criminal penalties. Please be advised that you will not receive any further warning with regard to this violation. If you should continue to sell misbranded and/or non-inspected meat products and/or poultry products, we will pursue legal action against you to invoke the penalties associated with these continued violations. I certainly hope this expensive action will not be necessary. An officer from this department will visit you periodically to verify compliance.
