**NOTICE OF WARNING**

We have an investigative Case Report showing that you violated the North Carolina Compulsory Meat Inspection Law. This reported violation was discussed with you on January 18, 2019. Specifically, our investigation revealed that you had stored, transported, offered for sale and/or sold misbranded (no State (NCDA) or Federal (USDA) mark of inspection or required labeling) and/or adulterated (unfit for human consumption) meat products wholesale to various retail stores for the sole purpose of resale to the general public. In a signed statement dated January 18, 2019, you stated that you stored, transported, offered for sale and sold misbranded and adulterated meat products to the general public.

Please be advised that the sale of misbranded and/or non-inspected meat products and the sale of misbranded and/or non-inspected poultry products is a violation of North Carolina General Statute (N.C.G.S.) §106-549.23 and §106-549.56 with civil and/or criminal penalties. Please be advised that you will not receive any further warning with regard to this violation. If you should continue to sell misbranded and/or non-inspected meat and poultry products, we will pursue legal action against you to invoke the penalties associated with these continued violations. I certainly hope this expensive action will not be necessary. An officer from this department will visit you periodically to verify compliance.
