NOTICE OF WARNING

We have an investigative case report showing that you violated the North Carolina Compulsory Meat Inspection Law. This reported violation was discussed with you on May 16, 2018. Specifically, our investigation revealed that you had processed, stored, transported, offered for sale and sold misbranded/non-inspected cooked pork skins to the general public at the Ayden Flea Market, 7835 NC-11 S, Ayden, North Carolina 28513, that were produced without the benefit of State (NCDA) or Federal (USDA) inspection. In a signed statement dated May 16, 2018, you stated that you processed, stored, transported, offered for sale and sold misbranded/non-inspected meat products to the general public for approximately one (1) day.

Please be advised that the sale of misbranded and/or non-inspected meat products and the sale of misbranded and/or non-inspected poultry products is a violation of North Carolina General Statute (N.C.G.S.) §106-549.23 and §106-549.56 with civil and/or criminal penalties. Please be advised that you will not receive any further warning with regard to this violation. If you should continue to sell misbranded and/or non-inspected meat and poultry products, we will pursue legal action against you to invoke the penalties associated with these continued violations. I certainly hope this expensive action will not be necessary. An officer from this department will visit you periodically to verify compliance.
