NOTICE OF WARNING

We have an investigative case report showing that you violated the North Carolina Compulsory Meat Inspection Law and the North Carolina Poultry Products Inspection Law. This reported violation was discussed with you on October 12, 2015. Specifically, our investigation revealed that you had processed, stored, transported, offered for sale and/or sold Tomato Basil Heritage Sausage pies, Chicken and Shroom pies, Spinach and Chicken pies, and Chicken-Mushroom-Leak-Sherry pies which did not contain State (NCDA) or Federal (USDA) marks of inspection or required labeling, for the sole purpose of resale to the general public. In a signed statement dated October 12, 2015 you stated you processed, stored, transported, offered for sale and sold misbranded meat products and poultry products without the benefit of state or federal inspection for the past three (3) months.

Please be advised that the sale of misbranded and/or non-inspected meat products and the sale of misbranded/non-inspected poultry products is a violation of North Carolina General Statute (N.C.G.S.) §106-549.23 and §106-549.56 with civil and/or criminal penalties. Please be advised that you will not receive any further warning with regard to this violation. If you should continue to sell misbranded and/or non-inspected meat products and/or poultry products, we will pursue legal action against you to invoke the penalties associated with these continued violations. I certainly hope this expensive action will not be necessary. An officer from this department will visit you periodically to verify compliance.
