NOTICE OF WARNING

We have an investigative case report showing that you violated the North Carolina Poultry Products Inspection Law. This reported violation was discussed with you on June 9, 2019. Specifically, our investigation revealed that you had stored, offered for sale and sold misbranded poultry entrees (buffalo chicken flatbread, chicken and turkey bacon flatbread, Hawaiian BBQ chicken flatbread and chicken parmesan) to the general public, that were produced without the benefit of State (NCDA) or Federal (USDA) inspection. In a signed statement dated June 9, 2019, you stated that you stored, offered for sale and sold misbranded poultry products to the general public for approximately four (4) months.

Please be advised that the sale of misbranded and/or non-inspected meat products and the sale of misbranded and/or non-inspected poultry products is a violation of North Carolina General Statute (N.C.G.S.) §106-549.23 and §106-549.56 with civil and/or criminal penalties. Please be advised that you will not receive any further warning with regard to this violation. If you should continue to sell misbranded and/or non-inspected meat and poultry products, we will pursue legal action against you to invoke the penalties associated with these continued violations. I certainly hope this expensive action will not be necessary. An officer from this department will visit you periodically to verify compliance.
