NOTICE OF WARNING

We have an investigative case report showing that you violated the North Carolina Compulsory Meat Inspection Law and the North Carolina Poultry Products Inspection Law. This reported violation was discussed with you on November 14, 2016. Specifically, our investigation revealed that you had processed, stored, transported, offered for sale and sold misbranded/non-inspected goat meat, cow feet, pork feet, pork andri and whole chickens to the general public without the benefit of State (NCDA) or Federal (USDA) inspection. In a signed statement dated November 14, 2016 you stated that you processed, stored, transported, offered for sale and sold misbranded/non-inspected meat and poultry products to the general public for approximately five (5) months.

Please be advised that the sale of misbranded and/or non-inspected meat products and the sale of misbranded and/or non-inspected poultry products is a violation of North Carolina General Statute (N.C.G.S.) §106-549.23 and §106-549.56 with civil and/or criminal penalties. Please be advised that you will not receive any further warning with regard to this violation. If you should continue to sell misbranded and/or non-inspected meat and poultry products, we will pursue legal action against you to invoke the penalties associated with these continued violations. I certainly hope this expensive action will not be necessary. An officer from this department will visit you periodically to verify compliance.
