Re: MATERIAL SAFETY DATA SHEETS NO LONGER REQUIRED

Dear Registrant,

On June 23, 2011, North Carolina Governor Beverly Perdue signed legislation that eliminated the requirement that registrants automatically submit Material Data Safety Sheets (MSDS) when registering pesticide products. Therefore, effective immediately registrants are to no longer submit MSDS to the office of the North Carolina Pesticide Section. Registrants still have the option of voluntarily posting electronic versions of their MSDS to our pesticide registration web site hosted by Kelly Registrations Systems. Contact support@kellyreg.com for information on how to do this. The North Carolina Pesticide Section does reserve the right to request copies of MSDS on an as needed basis.
