The Agronomic Services Division received final approval for increases in lab fees. The new fees are listed below.

Soil Testing: Important Notice

A \$5 Peak Season soil test fee was approved to take effect on March 2, 2026. To accommodate grower needs, the Agronomic Division will delay implementation until Fall 2026.

Soil Testing (*December 1 – March 31)	\$5


