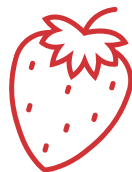

WHAT IS A PSA GROWER TRAINING COURSE ALL ABOUT?

A PSA Grower Training Course is an 8-hour course that will teach you the importance of produce safety as it directly relates to the Produce Safety Rule, as well as the skills needed to implement those practices on your farm.

WHAT SHOULD I EXPECT AT A PSA GROWER TRAINING COURSE?

A group of produce safety subject matter experts will present information on worker health, hygiene, and training, agricultural water, soil amendments, animals, sanitation, and required records related to your farm.

WHO SHOULD ATTEND A PSA GROWER TRAINING COURSE?

We encourage all produce growers to attend a PSA Grower Training Course whether or not the farm is covered under the Produce Safety Rule! The PSA Grower Training Course does also meet the Produce Safety Rule requirement that at least one supervisor or responsible party from the farm must successfully complete a food safety training recognized as adequate by the FDA for covered farms.

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
