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**INSTRUCTIONS FOR OBTAINING AUDIOGRAMS**

**I. PURPOSE**

This document is issued to ensure agency compliance with OSHA Standard 29 CFR 1910.95 by minimizing impact to employees' hearing from exposure to excessive noise levels. Included in this document are instructions for MPID employees who require baseline audiograms and annual hearing tests.

**IV. PROCEDURE**

The Area Supervisor or qualified designee shall record noise measurements in each establishment in the Area at a frequency of at least once per calendar year and whenever new equipment is put in use in an establishment. These measurements shall be posted prominently on the wall of the Inspector's office or workspace. All MPID Employees are required to wear hearing protection when they are in an area on an inspected establishment's premises where noise levels are 85 decibels or higher.

The Hearing Conservation Program of the NC Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services (NCDA&CS) includes all employees exposed to noise levels per the attached OSHA Table G-16. Area Supervisors shall determine which inspection assignments are subject to the hearing conservation program. The current employees holding those inspection assignments shall be recorded on the supervisor's quarterly Safety by Objectives Report.

**Baseline Audiograms** – A valid baseline audiogram shall be established for each employee exposed to noise at or above 50% daily noise dose (DND) and use for comparison with subsequent audiograms. This baseline can be obtained:

Before hiring or assignment to a job at which employee exposure has been identified to

be at or above 50% DND (known as a preplacement audiogram) OR

Within 6 months of an employee's first exposure at or above the noise levels and exposure times listed in OSHA Table G-16.

Testing should be preceded by **14 hours** without exposure to workplace noise. The employee should also be advised to avoid high levels of non-occupational noise exposure for the 14 hours preceding the test.

Area Supervisors are responsible for ensuring all inspectors requiring an annual audiogram in their area receive an annual audiogram between September 1 and October 30 of each calendar year.

The Raleigh Office has compiled the attached list of audiologists who have agreed to bill our Agency. These are the only audiologists that MPID employees should use. Each participating audiologist will be provided a copy of the NCDA&CS' Hearing Conservation Policy.

When making appointments for hearing testing and evaluation, it is imperative to remind the audiologist to send a copy of the hearing test results, including an interpretation of those results, to the NCDA & CS Meat & Poultry Inspection Division, 1001 Mail Service Center, Raleigh, NC 27699- 1001. The envelope should be marked "CONFIDENTIAL" and sent to the attention of Sharmila Logendran. MPID Employees should take the attached Memorandum to Audiologists with them to their appointment.

Audiology appointments will be paid by p-card over the phone by either Sabrina Iczkovits or Laura Zefiretto. Once an appointment is scheduled, the employee should notify their supervisor, Sabrina Iczkovits, Laura Zefiretto and Sharmila Logendran of the time, date, and location of the appointment. When the employee arrives for the appointment, they should call Sabrina or Laura who will provide a credit card number over the phone to the audiologist's representative for payment.
