

What is a home's risk rating?

Think about it:
How does the wildfire risk of
one home impact
neighboring homes?



Directions: Rate each criterion (using the assigned point values) as it applies to a home. Add the points to get a quantitative value, which relates to a risk rating score for the home (see page 2).

Start from your roof, work down to your foundation, and out through your landscaping and surrounding property.

Roof:	Score
Roof is fire resistant/non-combustible material (tin, tile, class A fiberglass/asphalt shingles. (0 points)	
Roof has non-rated/combustible shingles [usually found on older roofs (20+ years old)]. (10 points)	
Roof has cedar shake shingles. (15 points)	

Chimney:	Score
Chimney is for vented gas logs or no chimney exists. (0 points)	
Chimney has spark arrestor and is capped. (1 point)	
Chimney is not capped. (5 points)	

Attic Vents:	Score
Ridge vent is present. (0 points)	
Attic Vent is covered with 1/8-inch metal mesh screening. (1 point)	-
Attic vent is not covered with 1/8-inch metal mesh screening. (5 points)	

Eaves:	Boxed eaves →	Score
Eaves are boxed. (0 points)		
Eaves are not boxed, yet tight	tly sealed. (1 point)	
Eaves are not boxed, with cra which could provide access p	·	

Gutters:	Score
Gutters are not present. (0 points)	
Gutters are present and free of debris. (1 point)	
Gutters are present with debris, such as leaves and pine needles. (10 points)	

Siding:	Score
Home's siding is non-combustible, heat-resistant material (brick/block, stucco, aluminum, fiber cement, etc.) (0 points)	
Home has vinyl siding. (5 pts.)	
Home has wood or cedar shake siding. (10 pts.)	

Windows:	Score
Windows are double-pane, tempered glass. (1 point)	
Windows are single pane. (5 points)

Decks, Porches, Steps, and Landings:	Score
Decks, porches, steps, and landings are	
screened underneath with 1/8-inch	
metal mesh screening and lattice and/or	
underpinned. (1 point)	
Decks, porches, steps, and landings are	
not screened with 1/8-inch metal mesh	
screening and lattice or underpinned.	
(10 points)	

Attachments:	Score
No attachments. (0 points)	
Wooden attachments (such as fencing	
or trellis) are located 10 – 12 feet from	
the home or are made of a non-	
combustible material. (1 point)	
Wooden attachments are less than 10	
feet from, or are in direct contact with,	
the home. (5 points)	

Landscaping:	Score
Property is landscaped with fire-resistant plants. Shrubs are at least 5 feet from	
structures. Pea gravel, river/lava rock, or non-combustible mulch is used. (1 point)	
Vegetation and shrubs are less than 5 feet from the home. Pine Bark, pine straw, or other combustible mulch is used. (10 points)	

Overhanging limbs:	Score
No overhanging limbs. (0 points)	
Overhanging limbs have been trimmed	
to a height of 10 feet above structures.	
(1 point)	
Overhanging limbs are less than 10 feet	
from structures. (5 points)	

Structure to Structure Ignition Potential:	Score
Home is not within 30 feet of another	
structure. (0 points)	
Home is within 30 feet of another	
structure. (10 points)	

Perimeter:	Score
There is 100 feet or more of defensible	
space surrounding the home. (1 point)	
The home has 30 – 100 feet of defensible	
space surrounding the home. (3 points)	
The home has less than 30 feet of	
defensible space. (10 points)	

Combustibles (add all three scores):	Score
Combustible hazards (firewood, gas cans,	
gas grills, lawnmowers, etc.) are at least 30	
feet away from structures. Vegetation is	
cleared surrounding the hazards. (1 point)	
Combustible hazards (firewood, gas cans,	
gas grills, lawnmowers, etc.) are in contact	
with the home, its attachments, or are	
stored underneath the home. (5 points)	
LP gas tank is within 30 feet of the home.	
(+5 points)	
If brush surrounds LP gas tank. (+5 points)	

Driveway:	Score
At least 12 feet wide with 14.5 feet of	
vertical clearance to allow access for	
emergency vehicles. Cleared of brush	
and limbs. If there is a gate, it is 30 feet	
from the road, 2 feet wider than the	
driveway, opens inward, and has a key	
box if locked. (0 points)	
Less than 12 feet wide, cleared of brush,	
but has limited access for emergency	
vehicles. (5 points)	
Obstructed or minimized by uncleared	
brush with no access for emergency	
vehicles. (10 points)	

Mailbox and/or 9-1-1 address:	Score
Marked with 4-inch reflective letters & visible from both directions. (0 points)	
Marked, but is difficult to read (small letters, obstructed view, only visible from one direction, etc.) (5 points)	
Address is not marked (10 points)
