- 🐝 The NC State Fair General Fair Rules for Exhibitors apply. Except in cases of conflict, in which event the following rules and regulations will prevail, the general rules and regulations of the fair will govern this department.
- 🐝 Submit questions to: NCSFCompetitions@ncagr.gov
- 🐝 Pre-registration is required, either [online](#) or by mail. Make your entries early.
- 🐝 Open to all residents of North Carolina.
- 🐝 All honey and bee products entered in competition must have been produced by the exhibitor, in North Carolina, during the current season, with the exception of mead.
- 🐝 Exhibitors are allowed one entry per Class.
- 🐝 The right is reserved to reject entries received after all available space is taken.
- 🐝 Please take into consideration that entries made and brought to the fair too early may mold before judging and therefore will not be judged.
- 🐝 All honey displayed must be protected from honeybees and other insects.
- 🐝 Honey jars should have no labels.
- 🐝 Exhibitors are urged to personally deliver their exhibits at the Fair. Pre-paid UPS or FedEx shipments will be accepted if addressed to NC State Fair - Entry Dept, 4285 Trinity Road, Raleigh, NC 27609. Mailed exhibits must be received by Monday, October 5th. Mail entry items along with entry tags and any instructions inside the package. Exhibits should be packed with care, so as to arrive in good, clean condition.

MEAD

1. All meads should have been made by the exhibitor by the process of fermentation.
2. The spice(s) used must be listed on the back the entry tag.
3. Entries must not have any identifying labels on the bottle.
4. Natural cork stoppers are preferred for mead entries but screw top wine bottles or synthetic corks may be used. Corks may be straight cork or flanged and machine or hand applied. Corks are to be seated level with the bottle top or slightly below.
5. Wine bottles should be filled so that when the cork is pushed right home, the air space is between $\frac{3}{4}$ " & 1" in depth

RULES & REGULATIONS

-  All entries must be submitted **online** using your Association's information. This should include all classes your members expect to generate entries for.
-  A NC Substitute W-9 form for your Association must be uploaded at the time of entry.
-  Each Association can submit up to **one** (1) entry per class.
-  Booth space must be reserved by August 1st by contacting Adolphus Leonard (adolphus.leonard@ncagr.gov). Booths not requested by this date will be assigned by invitation. Booth space will be allocated on basis of show record of applicant if there are more applicants than available space. Booths may be assigned on a first come, first served basis.
-  Booth space assignments will be made before 9 AM Saturday, Oct. 10. Exhibitors may begin setting up displays at 10 AM Saturday, Oct 10 and must be in place for judging by 9 PM on Sunday, Oct 11, 2026.
-  There will be no peddling, hawking, or selling of any kind in or around booths that is not in keeping with Fair policy.
-  Booths must be kept clean and neat. All items not on exhibit must be removed from exhibit area or stored in storage space under the booth. No boxes or other material shall be left on the floor behind the booth.
-  County Association Display Booths will be comprehensively judged for the Class 37: Overall County Association Display Booth awards based on the rubric provided. Premiums and ribbons will be awarded. Associations must register for this class to participate.
-  The County Association Display Booth Sweepstakes winners in the Special Awards section will be determined by their placings of individual entries in Classes 01-36 within the booth based on a points system. Premiums will **not** be awarded for the individual class entries, only the overall Sweepstakes winners.

HONEY FOODS

-  All entries in this class must contain honey as one of the principal sweetening ingredients.
-  The purpose of this competition is to demonstrate skill in the use of honey in cooking. Therefore, the proportion of honey in the recipe will be a primary consideration in scoring by the judges. There are no other ingredient restrictions, and commercial mixes may be used. Factors such as whether the entry is representative of the entered class and freshness of the product will be considered in the judging. It will be the responsibility of the exhibitor to see that entries are correctly classified and tagged. The score cards used in the Baking Department will be used as guides in judging foods cooked with honey.
-  Place cakes on pieces of very heavy cardboard which has been covered with foil or wax paper. Cardboard should extend one inch beyond the cake on all sides. Punch a hole in the cardboard base so an entry tag can be tied through it. Entry tags will be mailed to you around the end of September. Place the unwrapped entry in a large clear food grade plastic bag (plastic wrap is not acceptable) with the entry tag extending outside the bag. You must supply your own plastic bag. Entries may be transferred to clear plastic containers by the judges for display. Any liquid entries should be in disposable containers.
-  Entries must be prepared from ingredients compatible with commonly accepted recipes for the class in which are entered. Each entry must be accompanied by a recipe on a 3"x5" or suitable card using only one side of the card (may be placed in a zip lock bag). Exhibitors are required to enter at least ½ of a cake and bread, 7 cookies or enough to cover an 8" plate for judging. Junior and Senior entries cannot be from the same cake. Commercial mixes are acceptable but not ranked as highly as items made from scratch. All entries will be discarded at the end of the Fair unless other arrangements have been made with the superintendent. Assistance may be provided to Junior participants but the entry must be primarily the effort of the entrant.
-  Please take into consideration that entries made and brought to the Fair too early may mold before judging and therefore will not be judged.
