

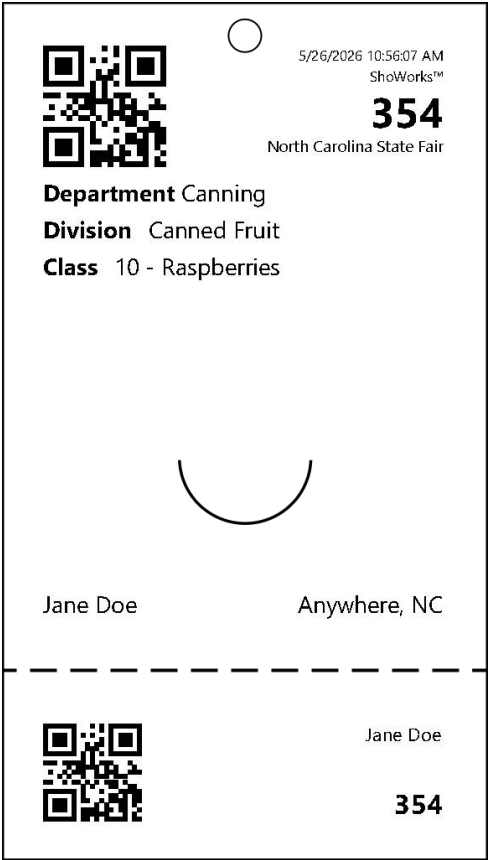

ENTRY TAG INSTRUCTIONS FOR TAKE-IN

- Entry tags will be distributed to exhibitors at the time of Take-In, unless otherwise noted.
- When you receive your entry tags at take-in, please abide by the following guidelines:
 - Do not permanently attach entry tags to exhibits. They may need to be moved for judging. Attach your entry tags by using strings, rubber bands, or low-tack tape.
 - Do not write anything on the front of your entry tag. You may write important information on the back.
 - Before attaching your entry tags, please ensure your name is on the entry tag and spelled correctly. If your name needs to be adjusted, please visit the Help Table inside Gate 12 upon arrival for Take-In.
 - Please remove the claim check at the bottom of your entry tag, and fold the bottom flap up to cover your name.
 - You must have your claim check to pick up your items after the fair.



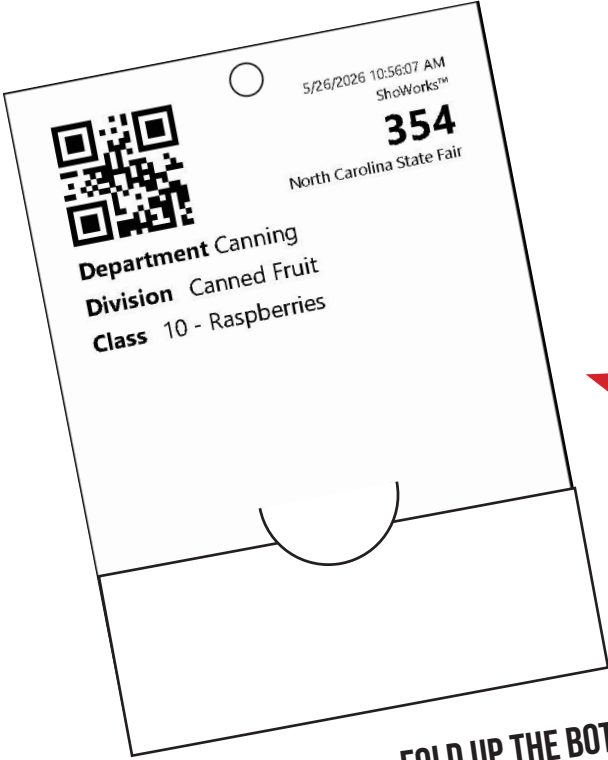

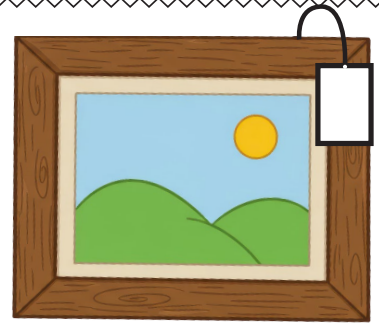

ENTRY TAG PLACEMENT INSTRUCTIONS

ART & PHOTOGRAPHY

- Tape to the back by the string and hang over the top right corner.
- Unframed school entries will be tagged upon take-in.



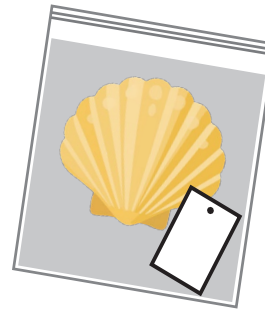
BAKING

- Tape to containers.
- Decorated Cakes - Attach to the cardboard base on the front side of the cake.



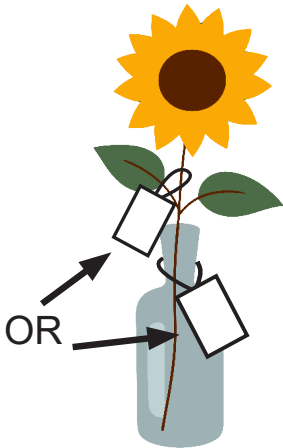
CANNING

- Must be attached to jars with rubber bands touching the jar under the ring.



HANDICRAFTS

- Items with handles - Tie through the handle or tape to the front of the item.
- Small or delicate items - Transport in cardboard or stiff paper inside a zip lock bag. Tape the tag to the cardboard.



FLOWERS & GARDENS

- Cut Specimens - Attach to the stem of the plant or the neck of the vase.
- Container Grown Plants - Tie to a bamboo skewer so the tag is above the foliage. Skewers are provided at Take-In.

SEWING & NEEDLECRAFT

- Pin tag with safety pins on the LEFT side of the article as it is facing you.

Left Side



VEGETABLES, FRUITS, & NUTS

- Small Items - Place on a paper plate at Take-In. Entry tag must be tied through the hole in the rim of the provided plate.
- Larger Items - Tie to stem or tape to side of item.
