Agriculture Cost Share Program

BMP Updates

The [Grassed Waterway](#) BMP has been revised to include a provision for using subsurface drains when necessary.

Updates to the [Detailed Implementation Plan](#) provide additional maintenance period options for Critical Area Planting, Cropland Conversion to Grass/Wildlife Plantings, Field Borders, and Filter Strip BMPs. Participants may choose:

- A 10-year maintenance period at current ACSP cost share rates (75% standard, 90% enhanced), or
- A 5-year maintenance period at reduced rates (60% standard, 75% enhanced). BMPs enrolled under the 5-year option are not eligible for reimplementation for 10 years from the original implementation date.
- New 5-year BMPs are available for selection in CS2.

Additionally, we are continuing to require third-party engineer designs for the Stream Restoration BMP.

Cost List

The Commission has approved the [ACSP Cost List](#) for the year. Because we are in year two of a three-year cycle, all costs remain unchanged. Updates include:

- One component name change: “Use Exclusion Fencing” is now “Site Exclusion Fencing.”
- Added explanatory footnotes for certain livestock exclusion components to clarify what each includes.

Agricultural Water Resources Assistance Program

Cost List

The [Cost list](#) was approved by the Commission with the following changes:

- The payment for Ag Water Storage/Collection System BMP increased to \$30,000 (75%) and \$36,000 (90%).
- Footnotes were edited, adding a clarifying sentence to the Water Supply Well cap statement and explaining in detail which items can be pulled from ACSP's cost list for designs.

Detailed Implementation Plan

Regional Application

The AgWRAP [Regional Application](#) is now live. Applications are due by 5pm on November 13th. As of right now, there is enough funding for 5-6 projects across the State, 1-2 in each region.

Community Conservation Assistance Program

Cost List

The [FY2027 CCAP Cost List](#) was approved by the Commission. There are no changes from the FY26 cost list.

Detailed Implementation Plan

The [CCAP FY27 Detailed Implementation Plan](#) was approved by the Commission with the following changes:

- New CCAP goal to update and develop JAA technical competencies for six BMPs: Backyard Rain Garden, Backyard Wetland, Cistern, Critical Area Planting, Grassed Swale, Riparian Buffer
- Allow FY2027 Stream restoration designs to be completed by Division engineers or 3rd party engineers.

Regional Application

The CCAP Regional Application is currently open and due September 30th. The application process has moved from Formsite to Survey123. This change was made to streamline, simplify, and save time on the technical mapping questions in the application. Instead of manually getting information from different maps, districts only have to put in the initial BMP location, and background calculations will autofill the mapping questions. Step by step instructions are available online for district staff to reference here [Access Regional Application Guide](#).

This year, the program has ~\$340,000 to allocate across the state, with the goal of funding 7-10 projects. The maximum allocation amount per project is \$50,000 and \$100,000 per district. Project awards will be approved at the January 2027 Commission meeting. Please refer the [Regional Application Process](#) for more information.
