



Hurricane Helene Round 3 Allocations

- **\$38 million** total to be awarded for Helene-Related Projects.
 - \$3.8 million will be withheld for future round of applications to address ongoing unmet need.
- 3rd and Final Application Round closed April 17th.



Applications Submitted in Round 3

- Applications in 10 counties.
 - \$40,111,860 requested in funding
 - Planned work would cover 67.5 miles of stream.
- 12 organizations submitted applications
 - 5 SWCDs
 - 2 County Government
 - 5 Nonprofit Organizations
- Approximate Benefits of Planned Work:
 - 741 Structures
 - 242 Utilities
 - 17.2 miles of Roadway/Bridge
 - 1330 acres of ag land.



- **Division Recommends Funding Sites that meet following conditions:**
 1. All Applications with Ranking Score of 35+
 1. All Stream Debris Removal projects with:
 - Rating of 3 or 4 (showing at least 1 significant blockage/impact on streamflow)
 - Length <10,000'
 2. All Streambank Stabilization/Restoration/Sediment Removal projects with:
 - Rating of 3+ (showing need based on bank material, bank slope, bank height, and lack of stabilizing vegetation)
- Sites with Rating of 2 may be considered for future funding if additional documentation shows need for work.
- Fund applicants the amount requested up to cost per linear foot caps (developed with Engineering Team):
 - Stream Debris Removal:
 - Segment >500': up to \$50/ft (unless additional justification given)
 - Segment <500': depends on stream width, up to \$100/ft
 - Streambank Stabilization: up to \$700/ft
 - May be eligible for additional funding pending engineering design
 - Stream Restoration & Sediment Removal: up to \$900/ft
 - May be eligible for additional funding pending engineering design

Ongoing FEMA work in Haywood County

- Last week the Division was notified that FEMA is still conducting ongoing stream debris removal work in Haywood County.
 - Several sites on the Haywood SWCD application are being considered for work through FEMA
 - FEMA has a September deadline to complete work.
- Recommendation:
 - Award Haywood SWCD funding for their approved sites that are NOT on FEMA's list for consideration (total: \$869,801).
 - Reserve the balance of county cap (\$626,449) so that remaining Haywood SWCD can revise their requests as FEMA completes its work.

Division requests that the Commission approve:

- **\$10,337,595 in funding to selected applications in Round 3 counties.**

- Supplemental funding available due to not all counties in previous rounds receiving awards up to the county cap.
- Division recommends awarding supplemental funding to grantees who have already applied that:
 1. Are eligible for funding.
 2. Did not receive funding, or received less than requested in initial award.
- Supplemental awards today would NOT include the \$3.8million (10%) withheld by the Commission.
 - These funds will retained for a Round 4 of applications, which will allow:
 - New applicant organizations to apply
 - Existing applicants to apply for newly identified sites.

Supplemental Awards

- Division Recommends awarding supplemental funding in the following conditions:
 - Funds will only be awarded to organizations that have approved applications/sites and either:
 - Were not funded (or received less than requested) due to county cap.
 - Had sites pending submission of additional information.
 - High & Medium need counties only.
 - To prioritize most impacted areas, DSWC will not issue supplemental funds in low-need counties.
 - Funding Amount:
 - County cap increased by 65%
 - Up to \$972,563 in additional funds in High-Need counties
 - Up to \$342,000 in additional funds in Medium-Need counties
 - If multiple applicants in a county, funds will be distributed based on ranking score.
- Proposed plan would increase total award to: \$33,999,831
 - Amount remaining for future allocations: 4,000,169
