STOP! Registration Renewal Due by January 1, 2026!

Please read completely before processing the 2026 pesticide registration renewal form.

The "North Carolina Pesticide Law of 1971" requires annual registration of all pesticides marketed in North Carolina. All registrations of pesticides registered for 2025 expire on December 31, 2025. Product renewal applications for reregistration of all currently registered products must be received by January 1, 2026, for the 2026 calendar year. Those products listed on the renewal applications not received by this date are subject to "Stop Sale, Stop Use, or Removal Orders" if these products are shipped and found in the channels of trade after December 31, 2025.

ALL INCOMPLETE APPLICATIONS WILL BE RETURNED

RENEWAL OF PESTICIDE PRODUCTS: Enclosed is your renewal form that, as of its creation, lists all products that were registered for the 2025 calendar year. Please complete the reregistration of these products by FOLLOWING THE INSTRUCTIONS ON THE FORM. Make a copy of the completed form for your records. If you registered any new product(s) for 2025 after the enclosed renewal form was created, you will receive a separate renewal form for those products.



NEW PRODUCT: To register a new product or to restore the registration of any previously discontinued product, complete a copy of the "Application for Registration of New Pesticide Product" for the product(s) to be registered. Follow the instructions on the application form.

FEES: The annual registration fee for each brand or grade of pesticide is \$150.00. An ENVIRONMENTAL TRUST FUND (ETF) assessment is also required for each product registered. The assessment amount depends on the sales of the product in North Carolina during the previous fiscal year from October 1 to September 30. If gross sales of the product were \$0 to \$5,000, the assessment is \$25.00 for that product. If gross sales for the product were above \$5,000, the assessment is \$50.00 for that product. New products require a \$25.00 assessment, since \$00.00 sales are less than \$5,000.00. Make checks payable to the North Carolina Department of Agriculture & Consumer Services or NCDA & CS. The pesticide registration fee and the ETF assessment can be combined on one check.

DISCONTINUED REGISTRATIONS: North Carolina has a one-year discontinuance policy. Each pesticide declared to be "discontinued" by the registrant must be registered for one year after distribution into NC has stopped. This is to give containers of the product a chance to clear the NC channels of trade while still registered with the state. Shipment into North Carolina must **not** occur during the discontinuance year. A registration fee and an ETF assessment must be submitted for each discontinued product. Products registered as discontinued for the 2025 calendar year do not appear on the 2026 renewal form. If you wish to re-register any previously discontinued product, follow the procedure outlined in the "New Product" section above.


CANCELLED REGISTRATIONS: To cancel the registration of a product without paying fees for the 2026 renewal cycle, the registrant must certify on the renewal form that none of the cancelled product remains in the channels of trade in North Carolina. See the Certification Statement on the renewal form for more information.

PESTICIDE REGISTRATION CERTIFICATION: Registrants will receive a Pesticide Registration Certification that certifies that the brands or grades of pesticides listed have been registered and their sale in North Carolina is authorized for the calendar year indicated. Due to high volumes of renewal applications coming in, you may not receive your certification until June.

APPLICATION REVIEW: Mail all new product applications to one of the addresses on application. Please follow the instructions on the application to ensure the applications are complete before submitting them. Applications for new products are reviewed first, and the renewal applications are reviewed second, in the order received.

LABELING: Include a complete set of labeling for each new product. See the instructions on the new product application form for more information. Revised labels may be submitted any time during the year. Do not send a copy of the EPA stamped, approved label unless we request it. **Do not submit labeling on CDs or USB sticks.** Please see the enclosed North Carolina 2026 Renewal Cycle leaflet for more information on submitting revised labels.

- **DELINQUENT REGISTRATION PENALTY:** The "North Carolina Pesticide Law of 1971" requires a delinquent registration penalty of \$200.00 for each brand or grade of pesticide found being offered for sale in North Carolina prior to registration. This penalty **MUST** be paid and cannot be waived.
- **2(EE) BULLETINS:** Send all 2(ee) bulletins issued for North Carolina uses, as you would supplemental labels and revised labels.
- **25(b) PRODUCTS, BIOTECH PRODUCTS, GENETICALLY ALTERED PRODUCTS, VIRUSES, ETC.:** Registration **IS** required for products exempted under FIFRA Section 25(b), biotech products, genetically altered products (such as B.t. corn), viruses, etc. Seed products that have been altered to produce plants that are herbicide tolerant are **NOT** required to be registered.
- FERTILIZER-PESTICIDE MIXTURES: Separate pesticide registrations are required for each fertilizer analysis even if the pesticide remains the same. These mixtures also require registration with the NCDA&CS, Plant Industry Division, Seed and Fertilizer Section, 1060 Mail Service Center, Raleigh, NC, 27699-1060. Phone: (919) 707-3756.
