System for Award Management SAM.gov Information

Introduction

System for Award Management (SAM) registration is required for any entity to participate in the USDA Food Programs administered by the North Carolina Department of Agriculture & Consumer Services Food Distribution Division. Follow the guidance listed below for registration details.

What is SAM.gov?

The System for Award Management (SAM.gov) is an official website of the U.S. Government. There is no cost to use SAM.gov.

You can use this site <u>www.sam.gov</u> to:

- * Register to do business with the U.S. Government
- * Update, renew, or check the status of your entity registration
- * Search for entity registration and exclusion records
- * Search for assistance listings (formerly CFDA.gov), wage determinations (formerly WDOL.gov), contract opportunities (formerly FBO.gov), and contract data reports (formerly part of FPDS.gov).
- * View and submit BioPreferred and Service Contract Reports Access publicly available award data via data extracts and system accounts

Who needs a Unique Entity Identifier (UEI) number from SAM.gov

All entities using an Employer Identification Number (EIN) and doing business with NCDA&CS must have a UEI number and current registration in the SAM database. This requirement pertains to grants and cooperative agreements. NCDA&CS requires applicants to obtain the required registration when applying for programs. Applications cannot be fully processed without this information. There is NO cost for registration in SAM.gov.

Tips for managing and establishing your SAM registration:

- Your organization will need to renew their SAM registration every year.

Annual Renewal of registered SAM.gov account

All system accounts need to be renewed annually if you have an active contract with NCDA&CS Food Distribution Division.
