

Piedmont Triad Farmers Market Pet Policy

We love our furry friends. Our Farmers Market is very crowded with customers and products and we want our two legged and four legged visitors to have a safe clean and enjoyable experience. In order to make this possible we ask all pet owners to honor the following rules:

- Due to liability and health concern, dogs and pets are not permitted in the selling areas of the Market. Service Animals are the exception to this rule.
- Pets must remain on a leash no longer than four feet and must be kept by their owners side at all times.
- Pets must be under control and well behaved on the Market grounds.
- Pets must be sociable with those attending on the Market or we will ask Pet owners to leave.
- Pet owners must clean up after their pets.

Pet owners need to be understanding that not everyone is an animal lover or is comfortable around animals. We understand people feel strongly about their pets. Some people love them and think of them as part of the family, as there are others that are extremely terrified of them. There are some that are concerned about sanitation and having dogs close to the food they are purchasing. An energetic dog can be a little scary to some young and older folks who may be unsteady on their feet.

So, please keep your pets in the open grassy areas and away from the food and underneath the open sheds and inside our Market Shoppes. We want the Market to be a welcoming place for everyone.
