Detailed Implementation Plan

CCAP Allocation Details:

- ~ \$340,000 is available for allocation in FY27:
- \$25,000 will be available for repair contracts,
- \$50,000 is the cap per project,
- District allocation is limited to \$100,000.



Detailed Implementation Plan

Fiscal Year 2027 Goals

- I. Conduct a competitive regional allocation process for CCAP BMPs.
 - a. Fund projects in each of the division's regions: western, central, and eastern.
 - b. Distribute funding for BMPs consistent with the Ranking Form with those of the highest ranking in each region receiving allocations until depleted.
 - c. Continue funding repair contracts as needed
- II. Continue to implement the program.
 - a. Maintain the [CCAP website](#) with all relevant information.
 - b. Provide support to update and develop ~~three~~ six Job Approval Authority Competency Exams for CCAP BMPs: Backyard Rain Garden, Backyard Wetland, Cistern, Critical Area Planting, Grassed Swale, Riparian Buffer.
 - c. Continue providing training and support to district personnel in developing technical competencies required to obtain Job Approval Authority (JAA) for CCAP BMPs.
 - d. Implement CCAP education and outreach efforts.



Detailed Implementation Plan

~~(14)~~ A stream restoration system means the use of bioengineering practices, native material revetments, channel stability structures and/or the restoration or management of riparian corridors to protect upland BMPs, restore the natural function of the stream corridor and improve water quality by reducing sedimentation to streams from streambanks. ~~All Stream Restoration BMPs this year will require designs to be competed by third party engineers.~~
