

NCDA&CS looking for part-time peanut inspectors

The N.C. Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services is looking for seasonal peanut inspectors to help during fall harvest. Inspectors will start as early as September with assignments lasting up to two months depending on harvest conditions.

Normal color vision, basic math and computer skills are required. Training will be provided. The starting hourly rate is \$10.34 per hour. The NCDA&CS is an Equal Employment Opportunity Employer, and provides an alcohol and drug free workplace.

New and returning inspectors must attend a job fair to complete an application and employment paperwork. Each applicant MUST bring their Social Security Card and a state issued ID or valid driver's license to the job fair.
