



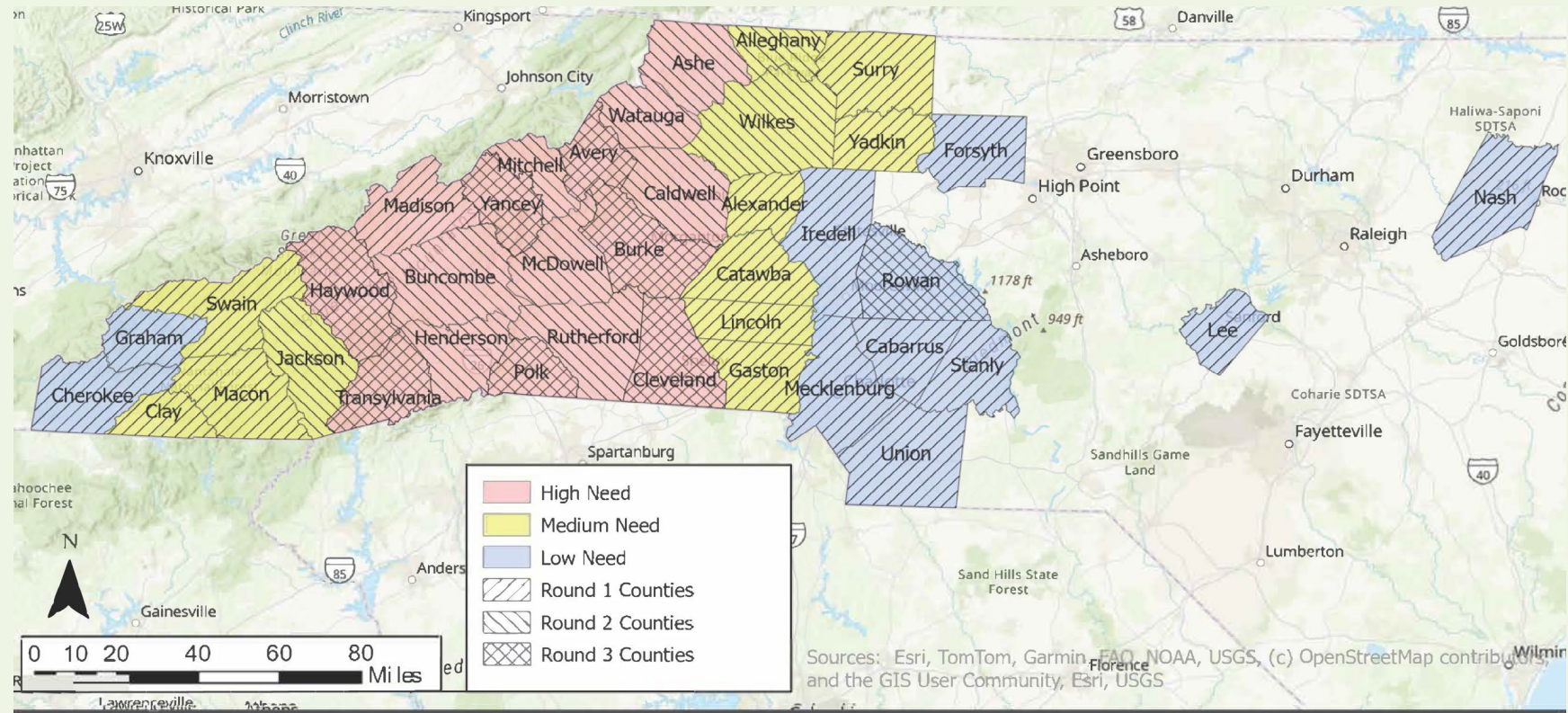
Hurricane Helene Round 2 Allocations

Matt Safford, StRAP Manager

- **\$38 million** total to be awarded for Helene-Related Projects
- 3rd and Final Application Round closed April 17th.
- Round 1 Awards approved at April 14th meeting:
 - In process of getting contracts in place



- Total Requests for funding across all rounds of applications:
 - \$93,396,263
 - 408 stream segments
 - 41 organizations applied for funding.
 - Proposed work for 180 miles of stream.

- Today's meeting will only approve funds for Round 2 Applications.
- Round 3 application review ongoing
 - 121 sites submitted in Round 3.
 - Total request of over \$38 million, but county cap for round 3: \$12.8 million
 - Ensure highest priority sites are funded
 - Multiple sites require additional information prior to ranking.
 - Conducting site visits as necessary by StRAP staff.
- **Request for called meeting in early June to award funds to Round 3 Applicants**
 - Virtual meeting date for Round 3 awards: Tuesday, June 16th, at 10am

Applications Submitted in Round 2

- Applications in 10 counties.
- \$32,449,086 requested in funding (out of \$12,052,212 county caps)
- Planned work would cover 43 miles of stream.

- 17 organizations have submitted applications
 - 10 SWCDs
 - 7 Nonprofit Organizations

- Estimated Benefits of Planned Work:
 - 498 Structures
 - 231 Utilities
 - 14.5 miles of Roadway/Bridge
 - 968 acres of ag land.



- **Division Recommends Funding Sites that meet following conditions:**
 1. All Applications with Ranking Score of 35+
 1. All Stream Debris Removal projects with:
 - Rating of 3 or 4 (showing at least 1 significant blockage/impact on streamflow)
 - Length <10,000'
 2. All Streambank Stabilization/Restoration/Sediment Removal projects with:
 - Rating of 3+ (showing need based on bank material, bank slope, bank height, and lack of stabilizing vegetation)
 - Sites with Rating of 2 may be considered for future funding if additional documentation shows need for work.
 - Fund applicants the amount requested up to cost per linear foot caps (developed with Engineering Team):
 - Stream Debris Removal:
 - Segment >500': up to \$50/ft (unless additional justification given)
 - Segment <500': depends on stream width, up to \$100/ft
 - Streambank Stabilization: up to \$700/ft
 - May be eligible for additional funding pending engineering design
 - Stream Restoration & Sediment Removal: up to \$900/ft
 - May be eligible for additional funding pending engineering design

Division requests that the Commission approve the following awards:

- **\$9,831,325 in funding to selected applications in Round 2 counties.**
- **\$774,459 in additional funding to selected applications in Round 1 counties.**

- **Total Funding Currently available for Supplemental Awards:**

- \$3,800,000 (10%) withheld by SWCC
- \$6,659,841 leftover from Rounds 1 & 2 counties

- **Causes for unmet need:**

1. Eligible applications not funded due to higher ranked applicants using whole county cap.
 - EX: 4 Applicants (6 total sites) in Buncombe county not funded due to higher ranked applications using entire county cap.
2. Applicants received less than requested due to county cap.
3. Applicants identified additional sites since applications closed.
 - EX: Some sites originally planned to be completed by FEMA no longer funded by FEMA
