Terraces

Definition/Purpose

A Terrace means an earth embankment, a channel, or a combination ridge and channel constructed across the slope to improve water quality. Benefits may include reduced soil erosion, sedimentation and pollution from dissolved and sediment-attached substances.

Policies

1. Smoothing and shaping for terraces is intended to be used only where existing terraces, diversions or other minor landscape features must be removed prior to initiating a terrace system.
