

OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE PLAN FOR PET WASTE RECEPTACLES

All pet waste receptacles and associated components must be maintained in proper working order for 10 years. At a minimum the following operation and maintenance items must be followed:

- Comply with all applicable federal, state and local laws and regulations regarding the operation and maintenance of the pet waste receptacle.
- Each receptacle must have a professionally designed sign describing the use and purpose of the receptacle. This signage must be maintained and legible at all times during the 10 year maintenance period.
- All waste bins/cans, whether attached as a part of a complete pet waste receptacle unit or located within the boundaries of the park or public area must be emptied at least once per week.
- Dispensers must be kept stocked according to a pre-established schedule.
- Any damage which causes the unit to not perform its intended functions must be repaired or the unit replaced within 30 working days. If it is determined that the damage was no fault of the applicant, cost share assistance may be available to help repair or replace the unit.

Any receptacles found that do not meet the list of requirements above or any other issue which causes a receptacle to not perform its intended function may result in the applicant having to repay a prorated amount of the cost share funds received to install the practice.
