5)	Storage - Storage Building needs to be organized and swept clean of spilled dry food to prevent insect/vermin problems - (17)	
5)	Storage - Quarantine Room - Area for freezer and cages needs a thorough cleaning - spilled shavings and rodent droppings - (17)	
5)	Storage - Cat Building - Extra cat litter is stored on the floor under the cat cages. This prevents being able to thoroughly clean under the cat cages. Cat Building is used also to store cat cages and other equipment. This area needs a thorough cleaning as well. (17) (15)	
7) 14)	All cat cages need to be thoroughly cleaned and repainted. Surfaces are rough and make adequate cleaning and disinfecting very difficult.	
7)	Dog Runs - Resting Surfaces - Discussed resting surfaces on past inspection and ACO stated folded newspaper was used. This is acceptable but if not used another surface must be provided - discussed the non-wood resting platforms.	
21)	Personnel - It is plain to see the ACO needs more personnel to adequately take care of the road duties and shelter duties.	
21) 24) 26)	Many of the intake records are incomplete. ACO stated the shelter assistant was not diligent in keeping accurate records.	
18)	Discard refrigerator needs to be removed from shelter grounds.	
Remember dog and cat enclosures must be cleaned at least two times a day and puppies and kittens shall be fed twice in a 24 hour period.		
Temperature in K-9 area was 70° at 2:00 pm and 80° in cat bldg.		
Re-Inspect in 60 days.
