

	Items to Address:	
7)	Quarantine K-9 pens - old chain link pens - The wire is loose in many areas and needs to be made secure. Discussed not housing dogs in these pens except when new pens are being cleaned. These pens are not strong enough to house vicious, large breed dogs.	
13)	Cracks in the concrete floors need to be kept sealed.	
15)	All chewed/damaged water tubs need to be replaced. Manager stated these have been ordered.	
20)	Open treats were found in the shelter. All open dry food and treats are to be stored in a covered-closed container.	
	Comments:	
	Temperature was 82° at 1:00 pm and 2:00 pm in the K-9 area of the shelter. The curtains were down and fans were blowing fresh air through the shelter. There were no odors in the K-9 or feline areas. The feline rooms had AC units running and temperatures were in range (50°-85°). Manager stated a new hooded AC unit has been approved for the shelter. Recommend installing thermometers in each cat room. Shelter temperatures are regulated by a thermostatically controlled cool-call system which is set at 72° which assures the shelter temperatures are kept within the required temperature.	
	It was noted that puppy size dry food was on site today as well as wet food.
