
If your browser blocks pop-up windows, you may see the Information Bar at the top of the NCVDLS window.

NOTE: We do NOT email the actual report. Your reports are confidential. For security reasons and protection of your identity, we prefer that you access the report yourself.

Therefore, we send a link to you via email which will send you to our site where a User Name and Password are required to access the actual reports.
